Reading comprehension for informational text is also becoming more challenging as the children move toward becoming prepared for fifth grade. The children are also learning about the Scientific Method through small team life science mold experiments. They are learning about California ranchos, and "becoming" a 19th century Mexican ranchero(a) who applies for a land grant and learns what life was like, back then.
