

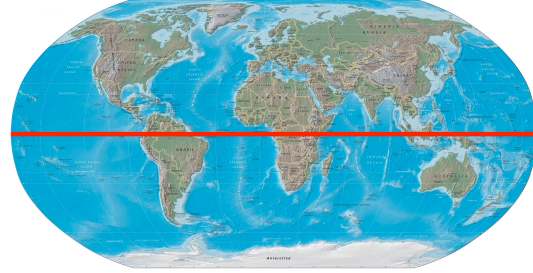
REGIONS Literacy Card 13



The wooly mammoth was an ancient creature that was important to early Californians. They hunted this animal for meat, and used its hide to make clothing and shelter.

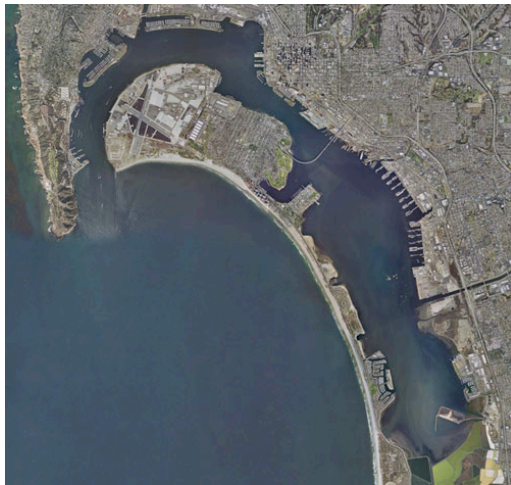
REGIONS Literacy Card 14
