Instructions


- 1. Choose a topic or topics. Circle your topic/s.
- 2. You do not have to be present to participate. You can email entries to <u>alfiawallace@yahoo.com</u>. Those who want to present or perform the poems need not have written a poem.



- 3. Use at least 5 of the words provided to construct a poem of any length on a sheet of paper or the back of this page.
- 4. Completed forms will be placed in the poetry slam box at the party. You may complete more than one. Collaborate or work alone.
- 5. At the appointed time those interested will congregate in the front room and those who choose to read/perform the poems will randomly choose them from the box and recite them to the amusement or mortification of others. Fun!

Topics (choose one per poem or mix-n-match!)

- 1. **The Long March of History**: Where have we been? Where we have been. Where are we going? Where we are going.
- 2. **Mother Maya?**: The Mayan calendar, Quetzalcoatl, hot tamales, what they can in the Yucatan
