- 3. Use at least 5 of the words provided to construct a poem of any length on a blank sheet of paper or the back of this page. Ideas for form below.
- 4. Completed forms will be placed in the poetry slam box at the party. You may complete more than one if it strikes your fancy. You may collaborate or work alone.
- 5. At the appointed time those interested will congregate in the front room and those who choose to read/perform the poems will randomly choose them from the box and recite them to the amusement or mortification of others. Fun!

(choose one per poem or mix-n-match!)
